Introduction

One of the Jané Mateu Foundation's main objectives is promoting, developing, advocating for and encouraging scientific-medical and pharmaceutical research, health services and all matters related to health, as well as sanitation and technological innovation through R&D&I activities, thereby improving citizens' well-being and quality of life.

Purpose

The purpose of the call for applications is to provide financial support for the development of research in the field of biomedicine.

Allocation and assistance payments

A maximum of six grants will be awarded. The financial endowment of each grant is a maximum gross amount of €6.000 to be paid as follows: one-third of the total amount at the time the grant is awarded and the remainder on completion of the research project. If the final research project is not delivered, the candidate undertakes to repay the amount already received.



Condicions

1. Applicants requirements

Projects will be led by a principal researcher who must meet all of the following requirements:

- Be a Spanish citizen or resident in Spain.
- Hold a PhD degree at the time the application is submitted.
- Have a link to an academic institution or public body dedicated to research via a professional or government relationship. The institution to which the principal researcher is linked must be based in Spain.
- Research projects geared towards research, dissemination or assistance in the field of biomedicine are eligible for this call for applications.

2. Project requirements

The project report must state any new points of innovation and progress expected to be made and their practical application.

Applicants must submit a report of at least 5 pages, written in Catalan, Spanish or English, including a budget, a work plan and a plan for the dissemination of the results.

The report must be submitted through the foundation's website by filling in the corresponding form (www.janemateufoundation.org). Applicants must also include their CV (including their contact details), as well as possibly an authorisation from the person in charge of the centre where the project will be carried out.

If the applicant is receiving any other assistance for the same project, they must clearly outline this in the report.

In the event that the project involves human or animal experimentation, a report from an ethics committee must be provided in accordance with the provisions of the applicable regulations.

3. Deadline for submission of applications

The deadline for submitting applications is 30 April 2023.



4. Deadline for the project

From the date the grant is awarded, the person or research team will have a period of one year to carry out the project. At the end of this period, a report on the research project must be submitted.

5. Selection process and resolution

Taking into account any advice it deems relevant, the Board of Trustees of the Jané Mateu Foundation will review the proposals received, and at an extraordinary meeting for this purpose will issue its decision There will be no opportunity to appeal any decision taken. The decision will be communicated to the researchers/teams that have been chosen and will be published on the Foundation's website.

Information on the deliberation of the Board of Trustees will not be provided.

Beneficiaries must send a formal letter of acceptance (free text, PDF format) of the grant. They must also take part in the foundation's institutional event, where the grants will be presented.

6. Research results and dissemination of research projects

The results of the projects will be in the public domain.

The winning projects may be published by the Foundation in any medium for public dissemination, on a non-profit basis. In the event that the authors of the awarded research projects publish or disseminate them, they must state that they have been financed by the Foundation.

7. Acceptance of the rules

Participation in the call for applications implies full acceptance of its terms and conditions.

8. Conclusion

Any unforeseen circumstances or issues related to the terms and conditions of this call for applications will be resolved at the discretion of the Jané Mateu Foundation Board of Trustees.
